What it does not tell you is that we operate under the premise that money can change situations, but it is through relationships that true life-change takes place.

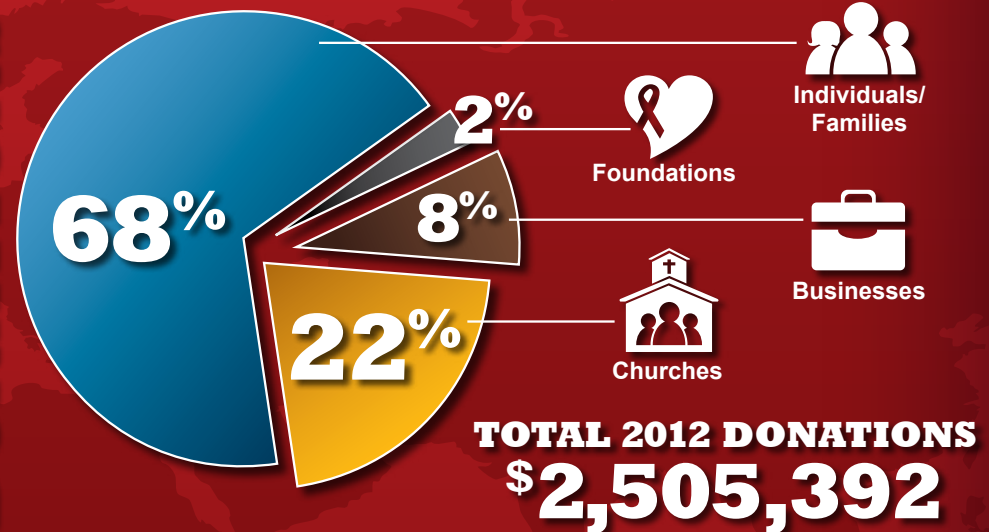

As you look over this report remember the statistics represent lives and it's people like you who help make all this possible.

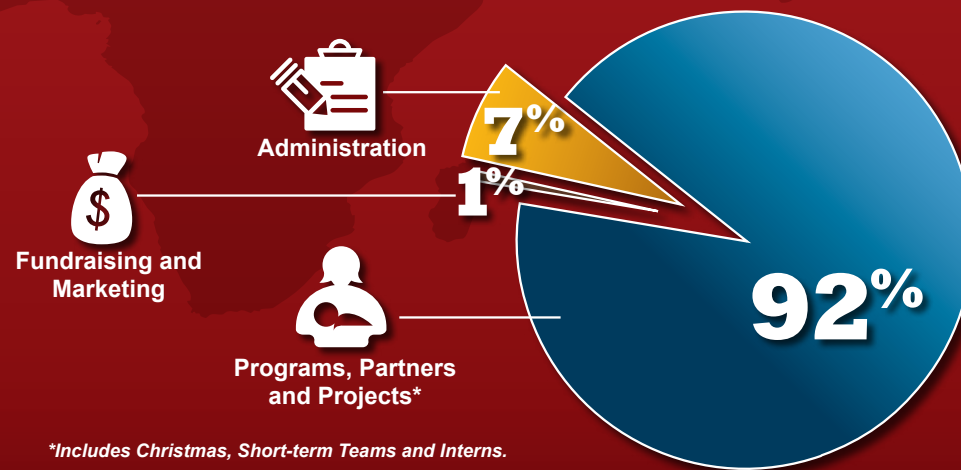

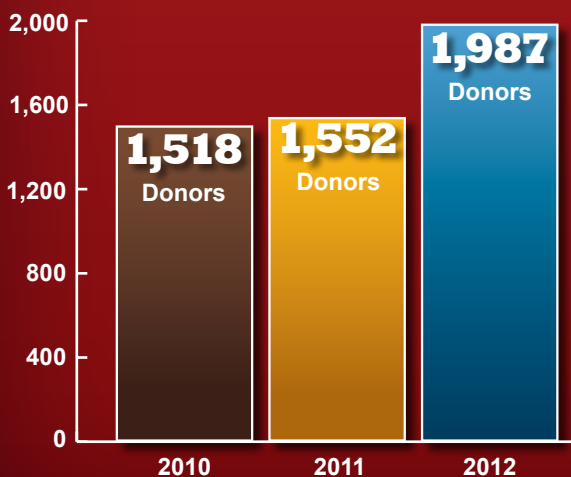

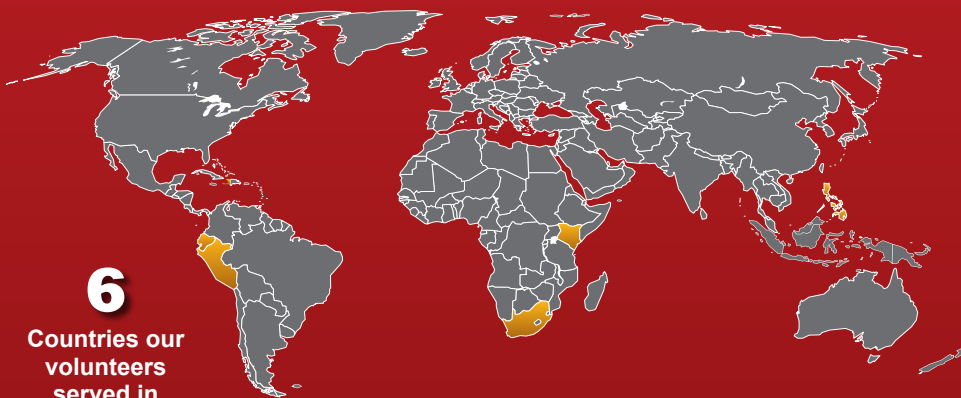
