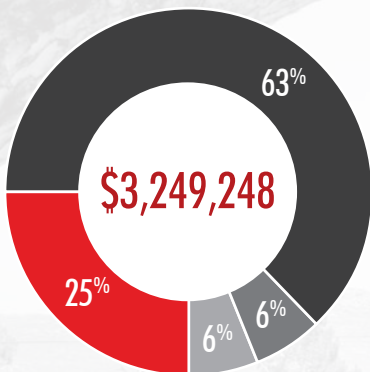




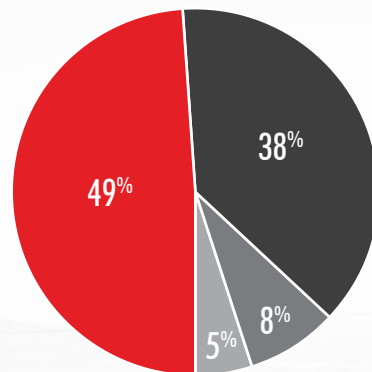

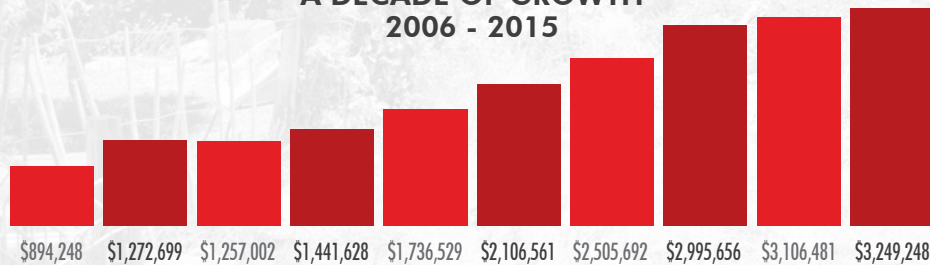

FIGHTING THE CYCLE OF POVERTY

POVERTY

3.1 billion people worldwide live on less than \$3.10 per day (World Bank).
22,000 kids die daily because of poverty (UNICEF).

ER fights poverty through nutrition, education, healthcare and skills development to create opportunities for lifetime sustainability.

HUMAN TRAFFICKING

21 million people are being used as forced labor. 4.5 million people are victims of sex trafficking, including more than 2 million children (ILO).

18,250 young girls have been rescued/restored through ER.
Another 6,826 have been trained to avoid traffickers.

HUNGER & NUTRITION

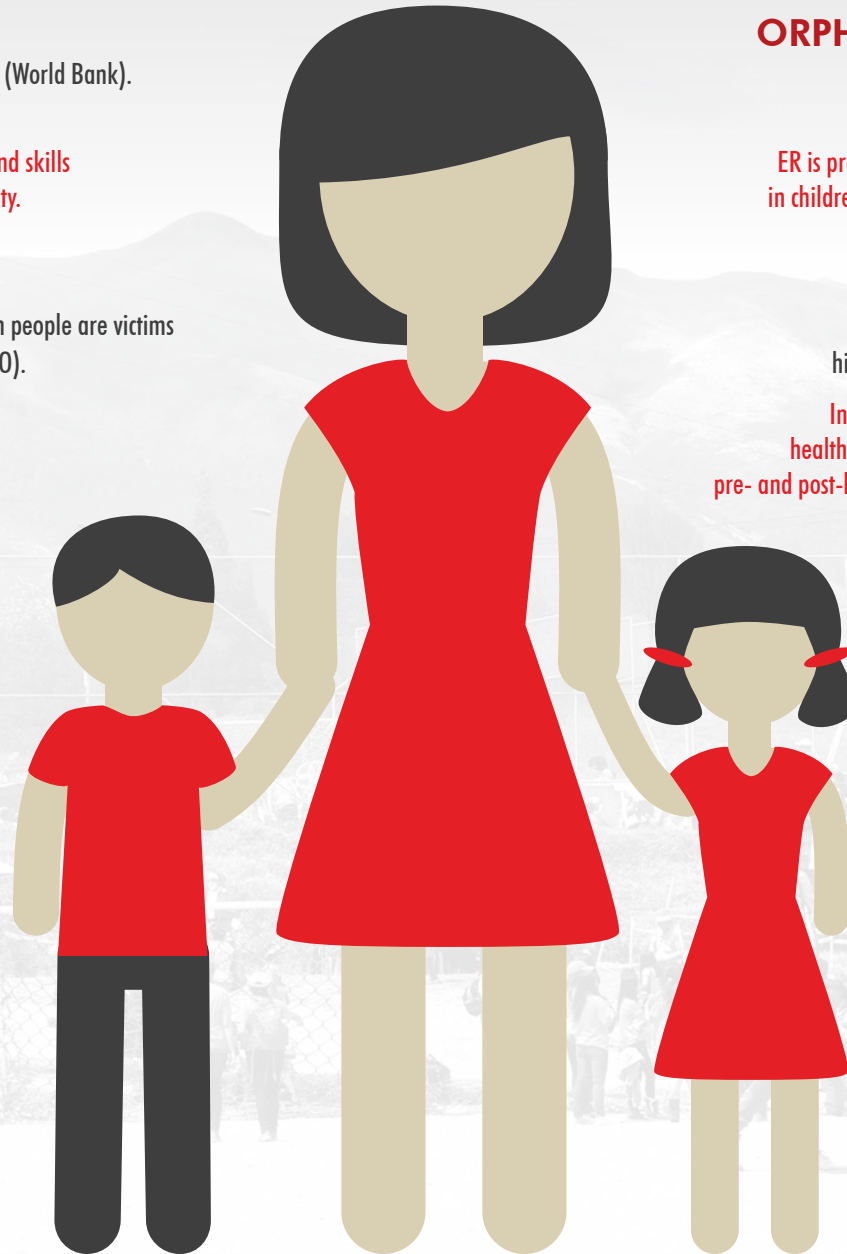
795 million people worldwide suffer from chronic under-nourishment, including 161 million kids in developing countries who suffer from stunted growth. 1 in 8 people in developing countries go hungry daily (UNFAO).

ER recognizes that well-fed people have greater capacity to learn and prosper. We're feeding more than 5,000 people in excess of 500,000 meals/snacks annually.

EDUCATION

63 million adolescents ages 12-15 are denied education annually (UNICEF).

ER is helping more than 4,000 kids with scholarships, school supplies, afterschool programs and tutoring.



ORPHANS & VULNERABLE CHILDREN

There are 132 million single-parent orphans and 18 million-plus double-parent orphans globally (UNICEF).

ER is providing shelter, food, education and care for more than 520 kids in children's homes. 2015 saw 11 adoptions and 35 family reunifications.

HEALTHCARE

Global Life Expectancy is 71.4 years, but much lower in high-poverty areas where ER serves (World Health Organization).

In impoverished areas, many people die prematurely. ER provides health screenings, cancer support, HIV/AIDS/TB testing and treatment, pre- and post-birth child nutrition and more to thousands of uninsured people.

LIVELIHOOD

Global unemployment is about 6% (ILO). But extreme low wages and poor job reporting in developing nations mask the severity of the problem.

ER provides skills training to more than 1,220 people, mostly women, to help them escape poverty.

SINGLE MOTHERS

Worldwide, 15.9% (higher in many countries) of kids live with one parent, 85% of whom are single moms who usually work (OECD).

Mothers often bear the burden of childcare and poverty. To combat this, we operate support programs in Ecuador, Philippines and South Africa.
